It began back in 1975 when a planning committee was formed to look at the way to best utilise, for community use, the old Camden Primary School site after its relocation. As a result of much determination by the group of very committed community minded people the Centre commenced operations in a two roomed transportable school building owned by and on the grounds of the Camden Branch, Brighton Technical and Further Education College.

In 1978 Camden Community Centre became Incorporated with a free-hold title.

We continue to be proudly owned and operated by the community through our membership [not government or council]. The Centre is managed by an elected volunteer Board of Management and a General Manager.
