It began back in 1975 when a planning committee was formed to look at the way to best utilise, for community use, the old Camden Primary School site after its relocation.

As a result of much determination by the group of very committed community minded people the Centre commenced operations in a two roomed transportable school building owned by and on the grounds of the Camden Branch, Brighton Technical and Further Education College.

In 1978 Camden Community Centre became Incorporated with a free-hold title.

We continue to be proudly owned and operated by the community through our membership [not government or council]. The Centre is managed by an elected volunteer Board of Management and a General Manager. The Centre is supported by Government grants, funding from the City of West Torrens, fundraising activities and public donations for which we are most grateful.

Over 70 volunteers play a major role in assisting our devoted and skilled staff with the day to day operation of our modern multipurpose facilities.
